**Administrative / Biographical history** Adalene Mary Warner [aka Adeline] was born in 1910 on a cattle property at Minerva Hills near Springsure, Queensland. Her parents were Sidney Albert Warner and Francis Shenton Moyle. When she was 21 years old, she married Edward William Prouse (1902-1991), they lived for many years at Tweed Heads.
