Also included is a 1970 calendar featuring a photograph of the family residence at 749 Rode Road, Stafford Heights. Also included is correspondence by Harold Schofield to his brother in England and relatives in Australia during the voyage on the ship "Largs Bay" in November and December 1947. The collection includes the original letters and a bound transcript with photographs relating to the voyage.
