Also included are K'gari / Fraser Island, Hervey Bay, Sunshine Coast, Minjerribah / North Stradbroke Island, the Whitsundays, and North Queensland locations. There are a large number of photographs of the Gold Coast, showing the development of canal estates and land reclamation.
