James enlisted in 1939 and departed for England in May 1940 with the 1st Anti Tank Regiment, serving in the Middle East from November 1940 and in Greece until May 1941 when he was wounded in action and taken prisoner at Sofia, one of the Greece islands. Interned in Germany for the remainder of the war until he was recovered in May 1945, James was returned to Australia in August 1945 suffering from psychosis and discharged from the Army in November.
