Abstract This collection contains material about the personal and professional lives of librarian James Stapleton, his wife Euthene Lebreton Stapleton (nee Grosser) and other associated material.

Scope and content The collection contains: personal papers associated with James Stapleton and his wife Euthene Stapleton (nee Grosser); a small number of professional papers and publications associated with James Stapleton; a photograph album mainly of holiday photos taken during a visit to Brisbane by Doris Grosser, Euthene Stapleton's sister; a photograph album documenting activities of James Stapleton and the Public Library of Queensland in the 1950s; loose photographs relating to the personal life of Euthene Stapleton and the professional and personal lives of James Stapleton; a photograph album mainly about James Lorenzo Stapleton, grandfather of James Stapleton and stationmaster of Barrow Creek Telegraph Station; a scrapbook of newspaper clippings about libraries in South Australia and Queensland during James Stapleton's career; and personal diaries belonging to Euthene Stapleton.

Description 3 envelopes of papers, 3 photograph albums and 1 envelope of loose photographs, 1 scrapbook and 3 diaries.

Administrative / Biographical history James Lawrence Stapleton (1904-1979) was born at Mount Gambier, South Australia, elder son of Percival de Soligny Stapleton, telegraph-operator, and his wife Louisa, née Lyford. Following school, James joined the Public Library of South Australia where he worked as a cadet until 1927 and then as a junior library assistant. In 1935, James married stenographer Euthene Lebreton Grosser (1909-1983) and from 1938 managed the Public Library of South Australia country lending service. In 1947, James was appointed State librarian of the Public Library of Queensland. James travelled Queensland to promote libraries. During his tenure, he established the structure for the State Library and oversaw considerable expansion of services with a country Lending Service approved by the Library Board in 1947, followed by the establishment of the archives section in 1959. Librarianship training classes were introduced during this period as well. By his retirement in 1970, the library had a staff of 120 and all but six of Queensland's 83 local authorities responsible for libraries had library services which offered free lending services. Following his retirement Stapleton served on the Oxley Memorial

Library Advisory Committee 1970-1972.(Information taken from: Australian Dictionary of Biography, viewed 20 November, 2023).

Notes In 1902, the Public Library of Queensland was opened in the redeveloped Queensland Museum building at 159 William Street, Brisbane CBD (often referred to as the Old State Library building). In 1959, the William Street library building was extended with the addition of Centennial Hall. In 1966, the building was remodelled with an additional floor and extended mezzanine. Outstations were established in George Street, Ann Street, William Street and finally Costin Street. In 1971, Public Library of Queensland became State Library of Queensland. In 1988, the State Library of Queensland moved to the South Bank Cultural Centre. (Information provided by: Anna Raunik)

The photograph album has a black cover and most of the photographs are labelled. The photograph album contains a small amount of other material. The photograph album belonged to Miss Doris Grosser, sister of Euthene Stapleton (nee Grosser). Photographs were taken during a trip Miss Grosser made to visit her sister between 1947-1949. Euthene and James Stapleton moved to Brisbane in 1947.

Scope and content

This item contains a photograph album containing black and white photographs relating to James Stapleton's time with the Public Library of Queensland in the 1950s. The Public Library of Queensland during this time was situated at 159 William Street, Brisbane CBD (now referred to as the Old State Library building). Photographs document:

- exterior views of the Public Library of Queensland, 159 William Street.

portraits of James Stapleton.

- interior views of reading rooms.
- library staff at work.
- collection items and storage.

There is also a photograph of a sailing boat build on plans and specifications provided by the library's Lending Service. Some of the photographs were taken at other locations. James Stapleton travelled around Queensland to effort to promote libraries (Information taken from: Australian Dictionary of Biography, viewed 22 November 2023). The album has a green cover and a black spine. It includes loose photographs. It is not known who compiled the album. The creator of many of the photographs is unknown, some were created by commercial photographers.

- black and white photographs of James Stapleton at functions, including the Library Association Conference, Adelaide, in 1957 and on his retirement in 1970.

Scope and content

This item contains a photograph album of photographs, photographic postcards and newspaper clippings primarily about James Stapleton's grandfather, but also his father:

- colour and black and white photographs, colour slides and colour negatives of a short tombstone marking the burial location of James Lorenzo Stapleton, stationmaster of Barrow Creek Telegraph Station, who died from a spear attack by Aboriginal Australians in 1874. The tombstone is located less than a quarter of a mile from Barrow Creek Station.
- colour and black and white photographs of a taller memorial for James Lorenzo Stapleton located in West Terrace Cemetery, South Australia.
- black and white photographic postcards of Barrow Creek Telegraph Station.

reproductions of original photographic portraits of James Lorenzo Stapleton, before 1859 and in 1864.

- colour photograph of Jim (James) Stapleton standing by the grave of his grandfather, James Lorenzo Stapleton.
- newspaper clippings that describe Percy Stapleton's efforts growing tobacco at Mount Gambier. Percy was the telegraph operator of Mount Gambier.
- newspaper clipping that documents the story of the spear attack on James Lorenzo Stapleton, shows the West Terrace Cemetery memorial for James Lorenzo Stapleton and describes Percy Stapleton's interests which include Aboriginal Australian implements.
- newspaper clipping that describes wireless telegraphy.

Some of the photographs were taken during a trip State Librarian James L. Stapleton took to Barrow Creek Telegraph Station where his grandfather James Lorenzo Stapleton was stationmaster. Percy Stapleton (Percy de S. Stapleton) was the father of State Librarian James L. Stapleton. This album has been rehoused.
