Abstract The collection includes war diaries, the diaries and journals of Reverend George Green, casualty lists, nominal rolls, maps, photographs and publications.

Scope and content Records kept and maintained by the 2nd Australian Light Horse Regiment during the First World War, serving on the Gallipoli Peninsula and the Middle East. The collection includes military records specific to the regiment such as nominal rolls, personnel records and casualty lists. It also includes the personal diaries and journals of the regiment's chaplain Reverend George Green who vividly describes the horrors of the Gallipoli campaign. The collection gives details of activities at Gallipoli and the Middle East and includes photographs, maps and publications.

Administrative / Biographical history Lieutenant Colonel Robert Stodart (1879-1956), was born in Brisbane to James Stodart and Elizabeth Gair. Educated at Brisbane Grammar School, he enlisted in the Queensland Mounted Infantry and served in the South African War. During the First World War Stodart was the Commanding Officer of the 2nd Light Horse Regiment, 1914-1915, and although wounded in June 1915, he remained on duty until evacuated in September 1915.

Scope and content

Diary kept by Reverend George Green at Gallipoli. The diary includes a harrowing description of the Australian attack on the Turkish position known as the "Chequerboard" on 7 August 1915 in which there were heavy casualties.

The diary includes three loose photographs: Turkish Field Battery, Turkish staff at Sherea, and General Allenby entering Jerusalem via Jaffa gate. Also included is notepaper from Gilgal Hotel, Jericho and a listing of ammunition.
